Warm Transferring Calls

A warm transfer involves speaking with the person to whom you are transferring the call. When doing a Warm Transfer, your caller is on hold.

- 1. While on a call, press the **\(\bigs\)** button.
- 2. Dial the party to whom you are transferring and press **Send**.
- 3. After speaking with the receiving party, press the button again to complete the transfer.
- 4. If the other person doesn't answer or can't take the call, press the **Cancel** softkey to go back to the original caller.

Blind Transferring Calls

A bind transfer involves transferring the call to another number without speaking to the receiving party, regardless of whether or not they answer. When doing a Blind Transfer, your caller is not on hold.

- 1. While on a call, press the **BlindX** softkey.
- 2. Dial the party to whom you are transferring.
- 3. Press the **Enter** softkey to complete the transfer.

Initiating a Conference Call

- 1. While on a call, use the **More** softkey, then **Confrnc**.
- 2. Dial the party whom you are trying to conference in and press **Send**.
- 3. After they answer, press the **Confrnc** softkey to merge the calls.
- 4. If the other person doesn't answer or can't join the call, press the **Cancel** softkey to go back to the original caller.

Accessing Call History

You must not have a call on the line when attempting to check your Call History.

Received Calls: Press the Left navigation key. Missed Calls: Press the Down navigation key. Placed Calls: Press the Right navigation key.



Checking Voicemail

You must not have a call on the line when attempting to check your voicemail.

- 1. Dial *86 on your phone.
- 2. Enter your voicemail passcode.
- 3. Select the option to listen to new or saved voicemails.
